To raise attainment in reading	We will continue with 1:1 reading for the children who are not at end of year expectation to not only help with decoding but to also foster a love of reading. Additionally, volunteers will receive training to improve the delivery of this intervention and to incorporate a comprehension focus as well. To improve children's speech and language skills	The SENCo is improving the Speech and Language provision in EYFS and KS1, which is an area of concern for our children who are eligible for Pupil Premium funding.	Pupil interviews
